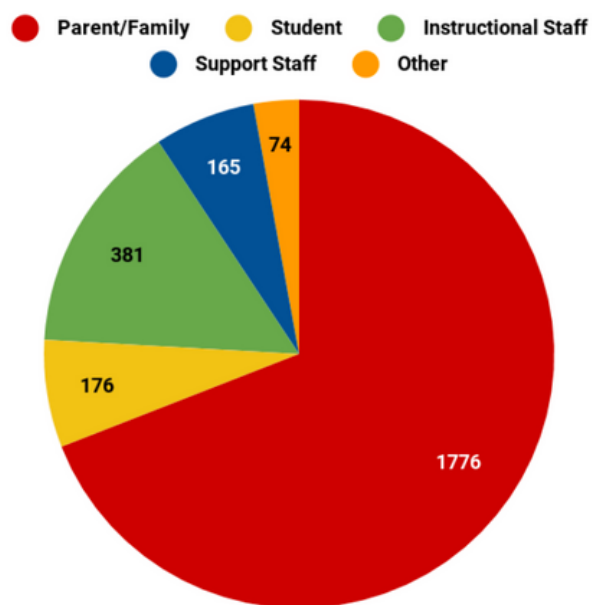


# JPS 2020-21 REOPENING SURVEY RESULTS OVERVIEW

The survey asked about confidence in returning to in-person instruction & which CDC-aligned health & safety measures are most important. All grade levels and schools were well represented in the survey.

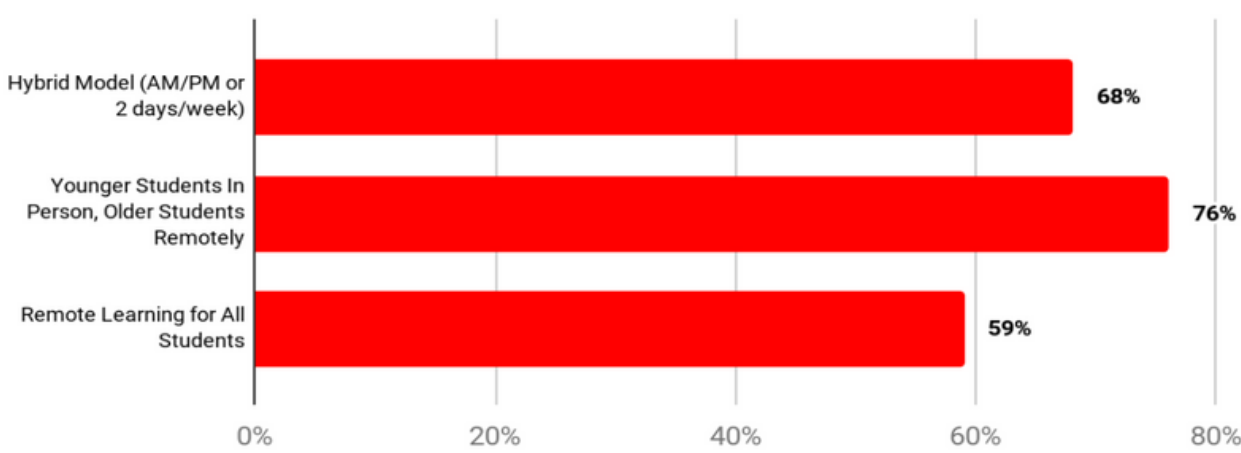

**WHILE MOST RESPONDENTS BELIEVE WE CAN RETURN TO SCHOOL SAFELY, MANY SHARED CONCERNS ABOUT POTENTIAL HEALTH IMPACT:**
